

Emilio Del Giudice

Emilio Del Giudice was born in Naples, Italy on 1-1-1940 and graduated with a degree in Physics in 1961. He was an Assistant Professor at the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Naples from 1963 to 1976, a Research Associate at the Milano branch of the National Institute of Nuclear Physics from 1976 to 1988, before becoming Senior Scientist in 1988. He has worked at the Center for Theoretical Physics of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA, from 1969 to 1972 and at the Niels Bohr Institute of Copenhagen from 1974 to 1976. His research field is theoretical physics and has he published about 80 articles on potential scattering dual models, electrodynamical coherence in condensed matter, and living matter.
